



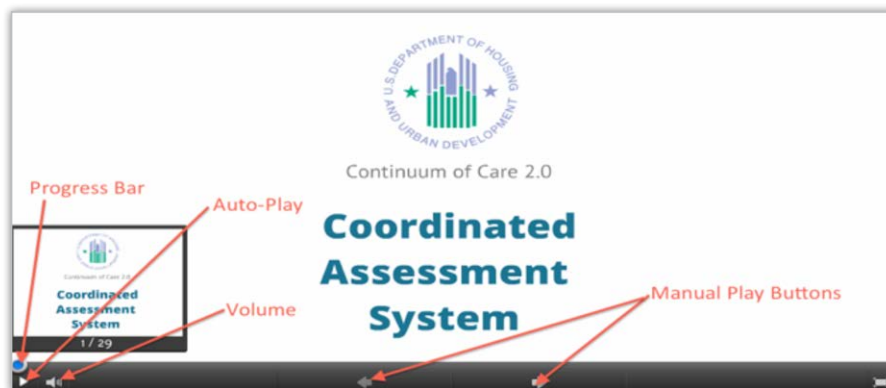

Guidance for Using and Viewing Continuum of Care 2.0 Prezi Presentations

Description of Prezi

Prezi is a specific type of presentation software. In place of slides and bullet points, Prezi uses a “zoomable” canvas upon which concepts can be displayed. The viewer navigates amongst the data and visuals along a pre-determined “path” to gain the knowledge being imparted.



How to View a Prezi

- » Prezi can be viewed using auto-play, or by manually clicking through the slides.
 - » Auto-Play: Click on the arrow at the bottom left of the slide window to activate.
 - » Manually Advance: To advance slides manually, or to go backward, use the arrows in the bottom center of the slide window. You can also advance or reverse and tell where you are in the presentation by positioning your cursor just above the black bar on the bottom of the slide window until you see a blue bar. That will allow you to move forward or backward as you desire.
- » You can also zoom in manually to navigate by clicking on a portion of the overview slides. However, the audio narration will not begin automatically when you zoom in on a certain slide. The audio narration will begin when you advance to the next slide using one of the arrow options.
- » Audio narration will begin automatically when you begin playing the Prezi using one of the arrow options. You can turn off the audio narration by clicking on the volume button to the right of the auto-play arrow.

System Requirements

PC & Mac: All major browsers (Internet Explore 9 and above, Mozilla Firefox 3 and above, Google Chrome, Safari) are supported; for the best experience, use Firefox 3.6+, Chrome 4+, or Safari 4+.

Adobe Flash Player 10.3 is required. Flash may be downloaded at <http://get.adobe.com/flashplayer/>.

iPad: To view on iPad, the Prezi iPad application must be downloaded. Once you have downloaded the app, you can tap the "download" icon in the center of the Prezi as viewed on the website, and the Prezi you have selected will start to download in the app.

Prezi FAQs

Q: Do I need a login or password to access this product?

A: No, Prezis are available without the need for a password or login.

Q: Do I need to download the product onto my computer in order to view it?

A: No, with an active Internet connection, you can view it directly online. Viewing it offline requires Prezi Desktop, and is only available to those with an active Prezi Pro license, which has a fee associated with it. Internet playback is free.

Q: How do I get it to play? Can I fast-forward or advance the content on my own?

A: See "How to View a Prezi" above.

Q: How do I increase the volume?

A: The volume of the Prezi can be increased by increasing the volume on your computer. Audio can be turned on or off by clicking the "speaker" icon on the bottom right of the Prezi slide. Relative volume of music to narrative is pre-set and cannot be adjusted.

Q: How can I share this product with someone else? Is there a way to forward it?

A: The link to the Prezi can be forwarded to anyone. Simply highlight the URL in your browser window, copy it, and paste it into an e-mail to forward to a friend or colleague.

Q: How do I print out the presentation and audio transcript?

A: The Prezi slides and the audio transcript are available for printing by clicking on the link shown in the screen shot, and printing as usual.

Q: Can I print in black and white or grayscale?

A: You can print the slides in color, black and white, or grayscale, depending on your printer's capabilities. To print in black and white or in grayscale, open the document, select Print, and find the option to print in black and white or in grayscale. You may need to click Printer Properties, and find the option in one of the tabs that appear.
